Brendan Fernandes and Kelly Jazvac are included in Barroco Nova, a group show organized by Museum London this Fall, which explores qualities of the Baroque that can be found in the work of contemporary artists. The show is curated by Susan Edelstein and Patrick Mahon.

Brendan Fernandes is currently featured in a solo exhibition entitled Disscontinent at the Surrey Art Gallery, curated by Jordan Strom, running from September 17 to December 11. His work is also featured in Location/Dislocation, a group show organized by the Justina M. Barnicke Gallery at the Jackman Humanities Institute in Toronto. The show is curated by Denise Ryner in collaboration with Barbara Fischer and runs from September 15, 2011 to June 15, 2012. Other group shows for Brendan this Fall include Never Odd or Even at the Grimmuseum in Berlin, No Sense of Place at the Bergen Kunsthall in Norway, curated by Elizabeth Byre, and Telefone Sem Flow at The Elizabeth Foundation for the Arts in NYC, and The Global Contemporary, Art Worlds After 1989, at the ZKM Museum of Contemporary Art, curated by Peter Weibel, Andrea Buddensieg, Jacob Birken, and Antonia Marten.

Peter MacCallum is included in Songs of the Future, Canadian Industrial Photographs 1858 to Today at the AGO. The show continues until April 29, 2012.

Upcoming in November the artist will be participating in McLuhan 100 with a new video text piece for the Pattision Video Billboard at 322 Yonge Street in Toronto. This video project is curated by Sharon Switzer. She is also currently included in the group show Eat Drink Man Woman at the Art Gallery of Mississauga until December 22nd.
