CANALS OF CANUCKS

Fast-rising fashion designer Jeremy Laing — one of the dancing wunderkinds behind Toronto's queer dance parties Big Primpin' — has been chosen to outfit the staff and curators of the Canada Pavilion at the Venice Biennale, the grandest visual arts fest in the world, opening Sun, Jun 7. Only one Canadian artist is chosen to represent the country at the biannual event. This year it's London, UK-based film artist Mark Lewis featuring his installation Cold Morning. In 2007 it was queer Montreal-based artist David Altmejd — whose biennale contribution is now at the Art Gallery of Ontario.
