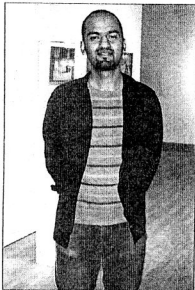


# RIGHTFULLY YOURS

**"Life is Art!!!"**

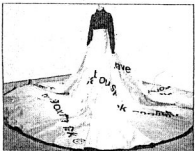
