

Summer Hawaii delves into the themes of misinformation and conspiracy theories in the digital age. This video installation invites viewers into a seemingly comfortable and neutral space, where they might stumble upon a video introducing The Lost Plan. Audiences are given the freedom to skip through or watch the video in its entirety, mirroring contemporary viewing habits and exploring how digital platforms shape attention and engagement.

Beyond the gallery, Summer Hawaii extends its presence into everyday spaces—its videos are duplicated and distributed to Toronto's video rental stores, libraries, IKEA showrooms, and thrift shops. By detaching the work from its curated exhibition context, it highlights how conspiracy theories spread and take root in everyday life, encouraging viewers to reflect on the connections between art, media habits, and the dissemination of misinformation.

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
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

THE STARTING POINT (WHY I MADE THIS PROJECT)

The starting point of this project is actually quite simple: I want to protect my sister's generation's right to self-identity.

Generation Z is the generation most profoundly and enduringly influenced by this era. I do not want to see a generation homogenized by the internet—absorbing excessive information yet becoming emotionally numb because of it. I do not want to see individuals, who should be uniquely flourishing, trapped in bubbles, with real-life communication becoming increasingly scarce. Even when in the same room, we rely on video calls to communicate. Honestly, I'm a bit tired of this.

SECHET

In the story of the Tower of Babel, after the tower fell, people could no longer understand each other's languages. They wandered through the ruins, unable to communicate, destined for mutual misunderstanding.

At first, the internet was seen as a tool to democratize information—allowing individuals to freely express their opinions and engage in public discussions. It seemed to hold the potential for inclusive participation, where every voice could be heard. However, instead of fostering true democracy, the internet has become a profit—driven machine where communication itself is commodified.


In recent years, the internet feels like one word to me—"noisy." People argue endlessly, groups clash, and no one convinces anyone. What remains are unresolved emotions and irrational, reactionary statements that confuse and frustrate others.

At first, I blamed the "echo chambers" created by algorithm-driven content, directing my frustration at the media and corporations. I wondered how things could change, but online, we seem trapped as emotional beings, locked in endless arguments.

Now, with artificial intelligence, the widespread dissemination of highly convincing false information has become a reality. In just a few words or a sentence, baseless falsehoods can be generated and spread. In this digital age, memories can be fabricated, and our behaviors and consciousness are being collected. We live in customized virtual worlds, and through immaterial digital lives, we exploit ourselves more intensely than ever before.

LABORATORY




As clues unfold in reality, the entire conspiracy theory will feel like falling into a rabbit hole-bottomless and ever-expanding.


Lastly, in my personal opinion, rock music, art, and design are the best tools for breaking down barriers and uniting humanity.









type 50m. diameter
